Teaching the know-alls

What do advanced students really need?

Advanced students often have a 'been there, done that' attitude; we tend to counter this with heavy literary text, 'difficult' vocabulary, and applied linguistics type tasks. Is this what they really need academically or socially? After a brief outline of his own experiences, Hugh will look at some of the types of materials that often found in advanced level course books and critique them. Then he will demonstrate that we do not have to resort to the 'academic' or the overly idiomatic to aid advanced students to learn.

Hugh is a teacher at the University of Westminster and has been teaching since 1993, mainly in London but for three years in Indonesia. He gives TT and development talks globally. He is co-author of the *Innovations* series and co-wrote the recent *Outcomes* series.
